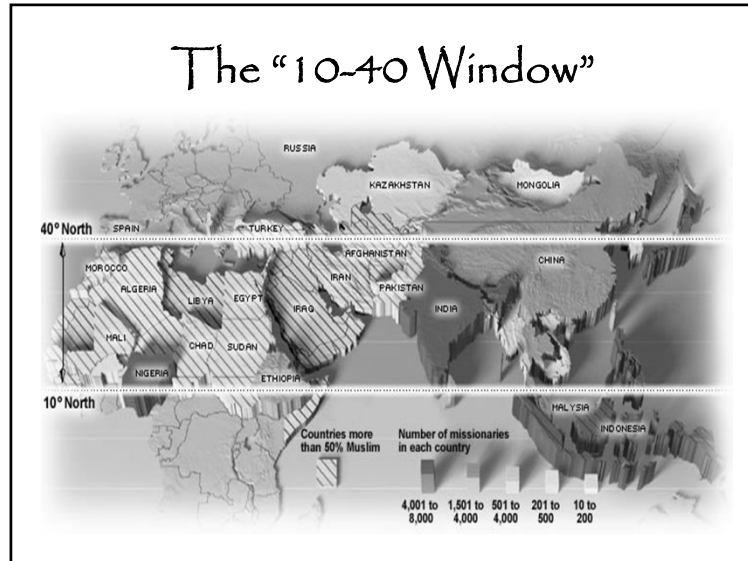

"10-40 Window"

"10/40 Window": term coined by Luis Bush (missions strategist) in 1990 to refer to the eastern hemisphere located between 10 and 40 degrees north of the equator (about 55 countries)

The 10/40 Window concept highlights 3 elements:

1. an area of the world with great poverty
2. and low quality of life combined with
3. little access to Christian resources.

Jesus' Message in the 10-40 Window

Center of population:
Two-thirds of the world's population (approximately 5 billion people) live in the 10/40 Window.

Unreached and Never Heard:
95% of the people living in the 10/40 Window are "not reached" with Jesus' message. Many have never even once heard the message of Jesus.

Jesus' Message in the 10-40 Window

Between 1/3 and 1/2 of the 7.2 billion people Alive at present have never heard Jesus' message.

Can we say they have "rejected" Jesus, even though they don't know enough about Jesus to reject Jesus?
